## Apostles Build Dedication July 15

The dedication of the Apostles Build house has been set for Sunday, July 15, at 2 p.m. The house, located at 206 E. 25<sup>th</sup> St. in Pittsburg, is the affiliate's first Apostles Build home.

An Apostles Build home is financed and constructed by 12 church entities. Each church is responsible for 1/12<sup>th</sup> of the cost of the house and also provides the volunteer help on one of the twelve work days used to build the house. The twelve participating churches are:
